ISTANBUL PROF. DR. MUMTAZ TURHAN SOCIAL SCIENCES HIGH SCHOOL ADMISSION POLICY

1. In our school, the IBDP program is applied in the 10th and 11th grades. Our school is a November school. However, in the 12th grade, students continue their education according to the national curriculum. Students who take Turkey in the Twentieth Century (TITC), Arabic or German as their 2nd foreign language take their exams in May of the 11th grade.
2. In our school, the IB quota for the period of November 2022-2024 has been determined as 40. Students will be able to choose one of the combinations based on Global Politics, Biology or Visual Arts courses.
3. The English and Turkish Language and Literature exam for admission to the IBDP program is held in May every year. The exam date is announced on the school's website in April.
4. Students applying to the program should take a proficiency exam in English and Turkish Language and Literature courses. Students are required to score at least 70 in these proficiency exams that measure reading, comprehension, speaking and writing skills. In addition, students coming from outside the institution and those who do not take visual arts courses in the institution should take the artistic skill exam so as to participate in IB education from the Visual Arts combination. They are required to get at least 80 in this skill test.
5. In cases where the IB quota is not filled, students from Prof. Dr. Mumtaz Turhan Social High School who get 60-70 from the admission exam and bring a positive reference letter from English and Turkish Language and Literature teachers will be admitted to the program on a conditional basis within the quota..
6. Students applying to the IBDP program must not have committed any disciplinary offences.
7. Parents are obliged to submit all the following documents required for the application to the school IBDP coordinator at the latest in the first week of the academic year.
 - Participation Specification
 - Receipt of payment
 - Student Recognition Form
 - Academic Integrity Student and Parent Agreement
8. The entrance fee to the IBDP program that parents must pay is determined by the school administration.
